Oscar

Rådhuspladsen 77, Copenhagen, Denmark

Bars

One of the most popular gay hangouts in Copenhagen. Oscar bar & cafe features modern interiors, along with cute staff and a non-smoking policy.

Live DJ's on Fridays. Outdoor terrace in good weather. Located at "regnbue-pladsen" right next to City Hall, close to many of our recommended hotels in Copenhagen.

Kattesundet 18, Copenhagen, Denmark

Bars

The oldest gay bar in Copenhagen and one of oldest in all of Europe. Centralhjørnet has been going since 1917.

Excellent shows are held every Thursday and Sunday (between October and April). Outdoor seating available during the summer months.

Jailhouse CPH

Studivestrate 12, Copenhagen, Denmark

Bars

Jail-themed basement gay bar & restaurant with uniformed bartenders and prison cell seating.

Jailhouse CPH hosts regular events such as Bear Night and Halloween Party. Located on the first floor. Open Thursday through Saturday.

Masken Bar

Studivestrate 33, Copenhagen, Denmark

Bars

Masken Bar is pretty much a Copenhagen LGBT institution. This lively, friendly music bar & café hosts regular shows and events, attracting men of all ages.

Busiest after midnight. Located a 5-minute walk from Town Hall Square.

Café Intime

Allégade 25, Copenhagen, Denmark

Bars

Located in the heart of upmarket Frederiksberg, Café Intime is a Bohemian piano bar & café, with a retro feel of the 1920's.

The bar features live pianists accompanied by great singers. A nice alternative to the majority of gay bars in downtown Copenhagen.

Never Mind

Dance Clubs

Late-night gay bar & nightclub in the centre of Copenhagen's gay scene. Never Mind serves a large choice of alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks. Smoking is allowed, and all attires are welcome.

Dance Clubs

With late opening hours and a small dance floor, Cosy Bar has more the feel of a nightclub. Best time to go is after 1am.

Vela Club

Lesbian Bars

The only all-girls bar in Copenhagen that doubles as a hangout spot and dance club. Vela Club is welcoming and lively space that welcomes everyone but largely caters to lesbian women.

Scandinavian Leather Men (SLM) Copenhagen

Lavendelstræde 17, Copenhagen, Denmark

Cruise Clubs

One of the biggest gay SM & fetish clubs in Europe. SLM Copenhagen has been in business for over 40 years! It features two bars, a large play area, wet room and dark room.

This club hosts themed nights with dress codes, including leather, rubber, uniform, army, sportswear, denim and construction. Pay attention to footwear requirements or expect to be declined entry.

Open on Fridays and Saturdays (sometimes Thursdays and Sundays). Check the website for details of current events. You will need to get a membership to get in (available for purchase).

Body Bio

Kingsgade 7, Copenhagen, Denmark

Cruise Clubs

Small, dark basement cruise club that welcomes all genders but mostly attracts gay and bisexual men. Body Bio has cabins, maze, dark room, play area and free internet café.

Sauna facilities are available (extra fees apply). Cheaper entry for 40 minutes before closing time.

Located a 10-minute walk from the Copenhagen Central Station.

Amigo Sauna

Studivestrate 31A, Copenhagen, Denmark

Saunas

Copenhagen's only gay sauna (Body Bio has sauna facilities, it's more of a cruise club).

Amigo Sauna provides a playground for gay Danes and visitors for over 25 years. Spread out on 3 floors, facilities include a dry sauna, dark room, maze, cabins, video room and shop.

Amigo gets busiest on Friday and Saturday evening. Located close to all the gay bars in the city centre.

Kafé KNUD

Cafés
